- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempte from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 2. If the bidder is a Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 3. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchas preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage o local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing

cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .The buyers are advised to refer the OM No.F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023. OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017.

4. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case o bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No.F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 50 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 50% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS (ATC)

Item: MANHOLE COVERS for P17A

- 1) **Pricing:** Price are firm and fixed till delivery of material to MDL Stores.
 - **2)** Refer Drg. no. 12651/1618-01 REV 1

3) Pre-Qualification Criteria:

The offers of the firms who are complying below criteria shall only be qualified for this procuremen

- i) Vendor should have past experience for supplying of any type of metallic manhole covers to a y ship building / submarine construction / Off-Shore industry / Marine Industry.
- ii) Vendor shall submit purchase order copies along with its work completion certificate or proof o execution in support of their past experience for technically qualifying under para (i) above.
- 4) **Delivery schedule**: Delivery date shall be as indicated in GeM Tender.
- 5) <u>Liquidated Damages (LD)</u>: LD clause shall be applicable as per GeM terms and conditions.
- 6) **Guarantee/Warranty Requirement:**
 - (a) **Warranty Period:** 12 months from date of receipt and acceptance of material. All other terms and conditions for warranty/Guarantee as per GeM.
- **7) INSPECTION**: It shall be TPI. Other general conditions related to inspection of material are as under:
 - (a) The decision of the Inspecting Authority or their representatives, as the case may be, on any questi n of the intent, meaning and the scope of Specifications / Standards shall be final, conclusive and I nding on the Bidder/ Supplier / Contractor.
 - (b) The Bidder / Supplier / Contractor shall accord all facilities to Purchaser's Inspectors / Nominated A ency to carry out Inspection / Testing during course of manufacture / final testing.

- (c) Bidder shall directly offer for inspection agency through a call letter under intimation to us and ens re readiness of the items offered for inspection on the scheduled date & time.
- (d) The TPI (Third Party Inspection) charges shall be directly paid by MDL to MDL nominated TPI agency to Indian Bidders. These charges shall not be included in the bidder's quote as MDL has separate c ntract with the nominated TPI agency.
- (e) Receipt Inspection: MDL with Warship Overseeing Team (WOT) shall carry out necessary inspection of the items on receipt in the MDL on the basis of appropriate MDL Inspection system requiremer s & the Inspection documents submitted by suppliers. Any objection raised by MDL inspection tear against quality of material or workmanship shall be satisfactorily corrected by the supplier at his e penses including replacement as may be required within shortest possible time within 30 days. Items damaged during transit shall also be rectified or replaced by the supplier within shortest possible time
- (f) **Rejection of the material:** Any portion of the equipment found defective/rejected, the supplier s all collect the same at his cost from the MDL Yard, all incidental charges being born by supplier, (in lusive of custom duty, if payable), within 30 days from the date of intimation to the supplier of such rejection. The MDL reserves the rights to dispose-off the rejected item at the end of a total period of 90 days in any manner, to the best advantage to the MDL & recover storage charges & any consequential damages, from sale proceeds of such disposal.
- 8) Indemnification: The Bidder / Supplier / Contractor, his employees, licensees, agents or Sub-Supplier Subcontractor, while on site of the Purchaser for the purpose of this contract, indemnifies the Purchaser against direct damage and/or injury to the property and/or the person of the Purchaser or that of P rchaser's employees, agents, Sub-Contractors / Suppliers occurring and to the extent caused by the egligence of the Bidder / Supplier / Contractor, his employees, licensees, agents or Subcontractor by making good such damages to the property, or compensating personal injury and the total liability fo such damages or injury shall be as mutually discussed and agreed to.
- 9) Purchaser's Property: All property (such as materials, drawings, documents etc) issued by the Purcha er or any other individual or firm on behalf of the Purchaser in connection with the contract shall remain confidential, being the property of the Purchaser and the Bidder/Supplier/Contractor shall undertake to return all such property so issued and will be responsible for any or all loss thereof and damage the reto resulting from whatever causes and shall reimburse the Purchaser the full amount of loss and dimage.

10) Issuance of e-Invoice by Vendor:

- (a) Vendors, whose aggregate turnover in any preceding financial year from 2017-18 onwards, excee s Rs. 5 Crores, as per GST Act, will have to issue an e-Invoice with a QR code and invoice registra on no (IRN). However, this rule will not apply to Micro with Udyam Registration No. (URN) as their urnover is less than Rs 5 Cr.
- (b) Whenever GST is applicable, payment will be released against e-Invoice, or Invoice accompanied with vendor's self-declaration that" we do not fall under the category of registered persons notific under Rule 48(4) of the central GST Rule 2017 and we are not required to comply with e-invoicing provisions under GST Act, as our aggregate turnover in any preceding financial year from 2017-1 onward has not exceeded Rs. 5 Cr as per GST Act".

11) Other terms & conditions:

- (a) Offer of the bidders who are debarred by MDL or issued tender holiday by MDL shall be rejected.

- 2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
- 3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
