- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be exempted from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking exemption from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption.
- 2. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.
- 7. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. #### 1. Generic

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

#### 2. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 50 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 50% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be (Increased quantity ÷ Original quantity) × Original delivery period (in days), subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

#### 3. Generic

## 4. Generic

## **PREAMBLE:**

Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited(Buyer), invites e-offers in Two bid system i.e. i.e. Part-I (Techno Commer cial Bid) and Part-II (Price Bid from Indian bidders (Seller) only on GeM portal for procurement of radar absorbing paints for Y-12651 to Y-12654 of Project 17A.

- a) Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) shall be in favor of MDL.
- b) Tender line items are inseparable and non-divisible in nature.
- 1. <u>Earnest Money Deposit(EMD)</u>: EMD shall be submitted as per GEM Terms &conditions. EMD exemption is as per GEM conditions, bidders shall submit valid EMD/EMD Exemption Certificate at the time of bidding only. In case valid exemption certificate is not submitted along with original bid then bid will be rejected. In addition to that, EMD is exempted for following:
  - a) Bidders registered with MDL. To qualify for EMD exemption, firms should necessarily submit valid copy of the Registration Certificate issued by MDL, for the tendered items for which the offer is being submitted, in Part-I offer/bid. ## f) LIQUIDATED DAMAGES (LD):

LD clause shall be applicable as per GEM condition @ 0.5% per week for delay in supply of material. Note: LD is applicable with maximum ceiling as per GeM terms and conditions.

g) Guarantee/warrantee Requirement: 12 months from date of receipt and acceptance of material.

All other terms and conditions for warranty/Guarantee as per GeM.

- h) **Performance Security (PS):** Performance Security is to be furnished within 15 days after notification of the award of contract and it should remain valid for a period of 60 (sixty) days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the supplier, including warranty obligations. In case any delay in delivery, vendo r shall extend the validity of performance security suitably
- i) <u>Inspection</u>: Inspection shall be done by MDL & ship staff. Other general conditions related to inspection of m aterial are as under.
  - a) Delivery challan shall be endorsed by the Ship staff and / or executive of MDL.
  - b) Receipt and acceptance of material endorsed by customer (ship staff) and MDL executive (CM & Above) & PS shall be submitted for payment based on relevant test certificates and reports.

Other general conditions related to inspection of material are as under:

- (a) Receipt Inspection: MDL with ship staff shall carry out necessary inspection of the items on receipt in Naval Dockyard Visakhapatnam on the basis of appropriate test certificates/reports submitted by sup pliers. Any objection raised by MDL inspection team against quality of material or workmanship shall be satisfactorily corrected by the supplier at his expenses including replacement as may be required within shortest possible time within 30 days. Items damaged during transit shall also be rectified or replaced by the supplier within shortest possible time.
- (b) Rejection of the material: Any portion of the equipment found defective/rejected, the supplier shall collect the same at his cost from the Naval Dockyard, Visakhapatnam all incidental charges being born by supplier, (inclusive of custom duty, if payable), within 30 days from the date of intimation to the supplier of such rejection. The MDL reserves the rights to dispose-off the rejected item at the end of a total period of 90 days in any manner, to the best advantage to the MDL & recover storage charges & a ny consequential damages, from sale proceeds of such disposal.

## j) **INTEGRITY PACT (IP):**

The Integrity pact essentially envisages the agreement between prospective vendors / bidders & buyers com mitting the person/officials of both the parties not to exercise any corrupt influence on any aspects of the con tract. Only those vendors/bidders who enter into such an integrity pact with the buyer would be competent to participate in the bid. Therefore, non-acceptance and non-submission of IP by the vendors/bidders shall be lia ble for rejection. The format of integrity Pact is enclosed with tender documents. IP shall be submitted on plain paper. The 'Integrity pact' dully filled as per enclosed format to be submitted along with the offer. Bidders to ensure that each page of Integrity pact shall be duly signed by the bidder. Non-submiss on of Integrity Pact by the bidders duly signed on each page along with Part-I bid shall be liable for rejection. Bidders shall send original IP immediately to MDL post submission of bid.

(2)	The Monitor is not subject to instructions by the representatives of the parties and performs his f unctions neutrally and independently. He reports to the Chairman & Managing Director of the Principal/Buyer.
(3)	The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) accepts that the Monitor has the right to access without restriction to all project documentation of the Principal/Buyer including that provided by the Contractor. The C ontractor will also grant the Monitor, upon his request and demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to his project documentation. The same is applicable to Subcontractors. The Monitor is under contractual obligation to treat the information and documents of the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s)/Subcontractor(s) with confidentiality.
(4)	The Principal/Buyer will provide to the Monitor sufficient information about all meetings among the parties related to the Project provided such meetings could have an impact on the contractual I relations, between the Principal/Buyer and the Contractor. The parties offer to the Monitor the option to participate in such meetings.

(5)	As soon as the Monitor notices, or believes to notice, a violation of this agreement, he will so info rm the Management of the Principal/Buyer and request the Management to discontinue or take c orrective action, or to take other relevant action. The Monitor can in this regard submit non-bin ding recommendations. Beyond this, the Monitor has no right to demand from the parties that th ey act in a specific manner, refrain from action or tolerate action. However, the Monitor shall give an opportunity to the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) to present its case before making its recommend ation to the Principal/Buyer.
(6)	The Monitor will submit a written report to the Chairman & Managing Director of the Principal wit hin 8 to 10 weeks from the date of reference or intimation to him by the Principal/Buyer and, should the occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situations.
(7)	Monitor shall be entitle to compensation on the same terms as being extended to / provided to I ndependent Directors on the Board of Principal/Buyer.
(8)	If the Monitor has reported to the Chairman & Managing Director of the Principal, a substantiated suspicion of an offence under relevant Anti-Corruption Laws of India and the Chairman & Managing Director of the Principal/Buyer has not, within the reasonable time taken visible action to proceed against such offence or reported it to the Chief Vigilance Officer, the Monitor may also transmit this information directly to the Central Vigilance Commissioner, Government of India.
(9)	The word 'Monitor' would include both singular and plural.

## **Section 9 - Pact Duration:**

This pact begins when both parties have legally signed it. It expires for the C ontractor **12 months** after the last payment under the contract and for all ot her Bidders **06** months after the contract has been awarded.

If any claim is made / lodged during this time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this pact as specified above unless it is discharged / determined by Chair man & Managing Director of the Principal/Buyer.

## Section 10 - Other provisions:

(1)	This agreement is subject to Indian Law, place of performance and jurisdiction is the Registered Office of the Principal/Buyer, i.e. Mumbai (For MDL).
