3. Earnest Money Deposit(EMD):

EMD shall be submitted as per GEM Terms & condition. EMD exemption is as per GEM conditions. In addition to that, EMD is exempted for following:

Bidders registered with MDL. To qualify for EMD exemption, firms should necessarily submit valid c opy of the Registration Certificate issued by MDL, for the tendered items for which the offer is being submitted, in Part-I offer/bid. 7. Inspection:

- (a) Receipt Inspection: MDL and Warship Overseeing Team (WOT)/Ship staff shall carry out nece ssary inspection of the items on receipt in the MDL on the basis of appropriate MDL Inspection system requirements & the Inspection documents submitted by suppliers. Any objection raised by MDL inspection team against quality of material or workmanship shall be satisfactorily corre cted by the supplier at his expenses including replacement as may be required within shortest possible time within 30 days. Items damaged during transit shall also be rectified or replaced b y the supplier within shortest possible time.
- (b) Rejection of the material: Any portion of the equipment found defective/rejected, the suppli er shall collect the same at his cost from the MDL Yard, all incidental charges being born by sup plier, (inclusive of custom duty, if payable), within 30 days from the date of intimation to the su pplier of such rejection. The MDL reserves the rights to dispose-off the rejected item at the end of a total period of 90 days in any manner, to the best advantage to the MDL & recover storage charges & any consequential damages, from sale proceeds of such disposal.

8. INTEGRITY PACT (IP):

The Integrity pact essentially envisages the agreement between prospective vendors / bidders & buyers committing the person/officials of both the parties not to exercise any corrupt influence o n any aspects of the contract. 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Section 3 - Disqualification from tender process and exclusion from future contracts :

If the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) before contract award or during execution of Contract has c ommitted a transgression through a violation of Section 2, above or in any other form suc h as to put his reliability or credibility as Bidder(s) in question, the Principal/Buyer is entitl ed to disqualify the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) from the tender process or to terminate the c ontract, if already signed for such reason, as per the procedure mentioned in the "Guideli nes on Banning of business dealings" Copy of the "Guidelines on Banning of business dea lings" is annexed and marked as Annexure-B.

1)	If the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) has committed a transgression through a violation of Sectio n 2 such as to put his reliability or credibility into question, the Principal/Buyer is entitled also to exclude the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) from future contract award processes. The Bidder shall be liable to p ay compensation for any loss or damage to the Principal/Buyer resulting from such rescission and the Principal/Buyer shall be entitled to deduct the amount so payabl e from the money(s) due to the Bidder.		
k)	In cases where Irrevocable Letters of Credit have been received in respect of any c ontract signed by the Principal/Buyer with the Bidder, the same shall not be opene d.		

(2) The decision of the Principal/Buyer to the effect that a breach of the provisions of this Inte grity Pact has been committed by the Bidder shall be final and binding on the Bidder, ho wever, the same Bidder can approach the Monitor(s) appointed for the purposes of this P act.

Section 5 - Previous Transgression:

(1)	The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last three years with any other company in any country conforming to the anti corruption approach or with a y other public sector enterprise in India that could justify his exclusion from the tender p ocess.	
(2)	If the bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the t ender process or further action can be taken.	

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Section 6 - Equal treatment of all Bidders/Contractor(s)/Subcontractors

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Section 8 - Independent External Monitor/Monitors:

(1)	The Principal/Buyer appoints competent and credible independent External Monitor for th is Pact. The task of the Monitor is to review independently and objectively whether and t o what extent the parties comply with the obligations under this agreement.
(2)	The Monitor is not subject to instructions by the representatives of the parties and perfor ms his functions neutrally and independently. He reports to the Chairman & Managing Di rector of the Principal/Buyer.

(3) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) accepts that the Monitor has the right to access without restri ction to all project documentation of the Principal/Buyer including that provided by the Co ntractor. The Contractor will also grant the Monitor, upon his request and demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to his project documentation. T he same is applicable to Subcontractors. The Monitor is under contractual obligation to t reat the information and documents of the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s)/Subcontractor(s) with confidentiality.

(4)	The Principal/Buyer will provide to the Monitor sufficient information about all meetings a mong the parties related to the Project provided such meetings could have an impact on the contractual relations, between the Principal/Buyer and the Contractor. The parties off er to the Monitor the option to participate in such meetings.
(5)	As soon as the Monitor notices, or believes to notice, a violation of this agreement, he wil I so inform the Management of the Principal/Buyer and request the Management to disco ntinue or take corrective action, or to take other relevant action. The Monitor can in this regard submit non-binding recommendations. Beyond this, the Monitor has no right to de mand from the parties that they act in a specific manner, refrain from action or tolerate a ction. (6)	The Monitor will submit a written report to the Chairman & Managing Director of the Prin cipal within 8 to 10 weeks from the date of reference or intimation to him by the Principa I/Buyer and, should the occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situat ions.
(7)	Monitor shall be entitle to compensation on the same terms as being extended to / provid ed to Independent Directors on the Board of Principal/Buyer.

(8) If the Monitor has reported to the Chairman & Managing Director of the Principal, a subst antiated suspicion of an offence under relevant Anti Corruption Laws of India and the Ch airman & Managing Director of the Principal/Buyer has not, within the reasonable time ta ken visible action to proceed against such offence or reported it to the Chief Vigilance Off icer, the Monitor may also transmit this information directly to the Central Vigilance Com missioner, Government of India.

Section 9 - Pact Duration:

This pact begins when both parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Contractor 12 mont hs after the last payment under the contract and for all other Bidders 06 months after the contract has been awarded.
If any claim is made / lodged during this time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this pact as specified above unless it is discharged / determined by Chairman & Managing Director of the Principal/Buyer.

Section 10 - Other provisions:

(1) This agreement is subject to Indian Law, place of performance and jurisdiction is the Reg istered Office of the Principal/Buyer, i.e. Mumbai/Kolkata (For MDL respectively). The Arb itration clauses provided in the main tender document/ contract shall not be applicable f or any issue/dispute arising under this Integrity pact.

(2)	Changes and supplements as well as termination notices need to be made in writing. Sid e agreements have not been made.
