- 3. Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:

  - d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.
- 4. Installation, Commissioning, Testing, Configuration, Training (if any which ever is applicable as per scope of is to be carried out by OEM / OEM Certified resource or OEM authorised Reseller.
- 5. Supplier shall ensure that the Invoice is raised in the name of Consignee with GSTIN of Consignee only.

If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period.
