Any objection raised by MDL inspection team against quality of materia I or workmanship shall be satisfactorily corrected by the supplier at his expenses including replacement as may be required within shortest possible time within 30 days. Items damaged during transit shall also be rectified or replaced by the supplier within shortest possible time.
 - (d) **Rejection of the Material:** Any portion of the equipment found defective/reject ed, the supplier shall collect the same at his cost from the MDL Yard, all incidenta I charges being born by supplier, (inclusive of custom duty, if payable), within 30 days from the date of intimation to the supplier of such rejection. The MDL reserv es the rights to dispose-off the rejected item at the end of a total period of 90 days in any manner, to the best advantage to the MDL & recover storage charges & any consequential damages, from sale proceeds of such disposal.
- 11.
