Consignee's right of rejection as per GTC in respect of the goods finally received at his location shall in no way be limited or waived by reason of the goods having previously been inspected, tested and passed by Buyer/ Consignee or its Nominated External Inspection Agency prior to the goods' shipment. 4. **Delivery Period:**

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90 days from the placement of contract date.

Note: Any deviation in the delivery period shall be liable for Rejection.

5. **Warranty:**

I. Two Years from the date of supply/installation against any manufacturing defect.

II. Any defect will be intimated to firm by e-mail as soon as MDL noticed.

III. Detail description and proof of faults or defects will be intimated either in photo or electronic file format for investigation.

IV. The Company shall at its discretion restrict itself to repairs/rectification/ replacement of the Component as a consequence of manufacturing defect

6. **Inspection:**

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i. **Pre-dispatch Inspection & Testing of Fume Extractor:**

Some of the tests mentioned in the scope shall be conducted at Manufacturer's Works by personnel using their own equipment's in the presence of MDL's representatives

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ii. **Receipt Inspection:** MDL shall carry out necessary inspection of the items on receipt in the MDL yard, on the basis of an appropriate quality assurance system and inspection system requirements, along with representative of the Supplier, any objection raised by MDL Inspection cell and user department against quality of materials or workmanship shall be satisfactorily corrected by the Supplier, at his expense, including replacement as may be required within shortest possible time within 30 days. Items damaged during transit shall also be rectified/replaced by the Supplier within shortest possible time. All additional cost towards replacement against defective items shall be borne by the supplier.

Rejection of Material: Rejected materials, if any, shall have to be promptly lifted by the supplier at his own expenses with his labour / transport as the case may be. Failure for lifting the rejected material within one week's time, from the date of intimation of the rejection, will be liable for disposal of the rejected material without notice and also for recovery of ground rent for storage of such material.

Note: Goods accepted by the purchaser at the initial and final inspections, in terms of the contract, shall in no way dilute the purchaser's right to reject them later, if found defective in terms of the warranty clause of the contract.
