- (a) Bid / Offer shall have the validity period of **30 days** from the tender closing date.

- (f) **E Invoice:** Wherever GST is applicable, payment will be released against e-Invoice, or Invoice accompanied with Vendor's Self Declaration that "We do not fall under the category of registered persons notified under Rule 48(4) of the Central GST Rules, 2017 and we are not required to comply with e-Invoicing provisions under GST Act, as our aggregate turnover in any preceding financial year from 2017-18 onwards has not exceeded Rs. 5 Crores as per GST act.

10. Inspection:

<u>Receipt Inspection</u>: MDL with CG Ship Staff shall carry out necessary inspection of the items on receipt in the MDL on the basis of appropriate MDL Inspection system requirements & the Inspection documents submitted by suppliers. Any objection raised by MDL inspection team against quality of material or workmanship shall be satisfactorily corrected by the supplier at his expenses including replacement as may be required within shortest possible time within 30 days. Items damaged during transit shall also be rectified or replaced by the supplier within shortest possible time.

Rejection of the material: Any portion of the equipment found defective/rejected, the supplier shall collect the same at his cost from the MDL Yard, all incidental charges being born by supplier, (inclusive of custom duty, if payable), within 30 days from the date of intimation to the supplier of such rejection. The MDL reserves the rights to dispose-off the rejected item at the end of a total period of 90 days in any manner, to the best advantage to the MDL & recover storage charges & any consequential damages, from sale proceeds of such disposal.

- 11. **LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:** Time is the essence of Contract/Order. - 13. **Breach of Obligation:** In case of breach of any obligation mentioned under, the bidder shall be disqualified / debarred from the bidding process for a period of one year from the date of notification;

- 14. Public Procurement Policy (Preference to Make In India) Order 2017: The Government of India has issued revised Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) order 2017 on 16th Sep' 2020 as part of its policy to encourage "Make in India" and promote manufacturing and production of goods and services in India with a view to enhancing income and employment. Subject to the provisions of this order and to any specific instructions issued by Nodal Ministry or in pursuance of this order, Purchase Preference shall be given to local suppliers in all the procurements undertaken by MDL in the manner specified below:
 - (a) **Aspects of 'Preference to Make in India':** The following terminology / definitions used in the policy is enumerated below and applicable to the tender:
 - (i) **Local content:** means the amount of value added in India which shall be the total value of item (goods, services or works or their combination) under procurement (excluding net domestic indirect taxes) minus the value of imported content in the item (including all customs duties) as a proportion of the total value in percent. Different definition of Local Content may be specified by the Nodal Ministry for items assigned to them, which will prevail over above.

Note:

- a. The local content can be increased by vendors through partnerships, cooperation with local companies, establishing production units in India or Joint Ventures (JV) with Indian suppliers, increasing the participation of local employees in services and training them.
- b. Any participating bidder shall not be Joint Venture/Consortium; except in case of manufacture under license/technology collaboration agreements with phased indigenization under the PPP Make-in-India Policy 2017.
- (ii) Class-I Local Supplier: means a supplier or service provider, whose goods, services or works offered for procurement, meets the minimum local content of 50%.

(b) **Declaration/Verification of Local content:**

SECTION 2(B) ; "PROHIBITED PLACE"

It is defined as the place of any work of Defence Dockyard and other so belonging or occupied and used for the purpose of building, repairing, making or storing any ammunitions of war.

For the purpose of the above definition, sketch includes any photograph or other mode of representing any place or thing.

SECTION 3: "PENALTIES FOR SPYING"

If any per unlawfully -

- a) approaches, inspects, passes over or is in the vicinity of any clear place; or
- b) make any sketches intended to be directly or indirectly useful to an enemy; or
- c) obtains, collects, records or communicates to any other person any secret official code.

SECTION 4: "COMMUNICATION WITH FOREIGN AGENTS"

If Any person has been in communication with or attempted to communicate with foreign agents regarding the vital information of any "PROHIBITED PLACE" would be guilty of violating the provisions of this Act.

SECTION 5: "WRONGFUL COMMUNICATION OF INFORMATION"

If any person having in his possession or control any official document;

- a) Willfully communicates to any person, other than a person, who is authorised to communicate it.
- b) Used the information in his possession for the benefit of any foreign power.
- c) Retain in his possession when he has no power to retain it
- d) Fails to take reasonable care of it.

SECTION 6: "UNAUTHORISED USE OF UNIFORMS"

SECTION 8: "DUTY OF GIVING INFORMATION"

It shall be duty of every person to give on demand to a superintendent of Police or any other Police Officer not below the rank of Inspector, any information in his power relating to an offence under this Act. If any person fails to give such information, shall be punishable with imprisonment to 3 years or fine or with both.

SECTION 9: "INCITEMENT"

Any person who attempts to commit or debate the commission of an offence under this Act shall be punishable with the same punishment and be liable to be proceeded against in the same manner as if he had committed such offence.

SECTION 10: "PENALTY FOR HARBOURING SPIES"

If any person whom he knows or has reasonable grounds for supposing to be person who is about to commit or who has committed offence under this Act shall be guilty of offence under this Section.

SECTION 11: "SEARCH WARRANTS"

If a presidency Magistrate, Magistrate First Class or Sub-Divisional magistrate is satisfied with the information that there is reasonable ground for suspecting that an offence under this Act has been or is about to be committed, he may grant search warrant to any Police Officer to enter at any time any premises to force to search premises or the places.
