- 2. <u>Item/Scope of Work(SOW):</u> The detailed SOW includes design, Fabrication, testing, Commi sioning and Supply of Multipurpose Fire Tender (Water & Foam) along with supply of equipment 's & Accessories as per details mentioned in the Technical specification/Gem bid.
- 3. <u>Delivery</u>: Delivery date of items shall be as indicated in GeM Tender. The delivery of complete vehicle up to Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Itd Mumbai-400010 is under the scope of supplier wi hin 240 days after placement of order. For details refer Technical specification.
- i. Submission of detailed drawing after placement of order by seller- 3 weeks i.e. 21 days.
- ii. Timelines for MDL executive of CM & above rank to approve the drawings is 02 weeks i.e. 14d ys.

4. Bid Rejection criteria

- iii. Bid Non-compliance/non-acceptance to any of the terms and conditions of the tender shall be lable for rejection.
- iv. Any deviation in delivery period shall also falls under liable for rejection.

NOTE:

- a. Start-ups shall be given 100% relaxation in prior turnover and prior experience subject to meet ng of quality and technical specification and bidder shall submit the valid start-up certificate as recognized by Department of Industrial policy and promotion (DIPP).
- b. MSEs shall be given 100% relaxation in prior turnover and prior experience subject to meeting of quality and technical specification and bidder shall submit the valid MSE Udyam certificate.
- 6) <u>Guarantee/warrantee Requirement</u>: The successful tenderer will have to furnish a maintenance go arantee, undertaking for service, repairs, replacement, maintenance etc. against any defects in he material used, body, construction, Engine, Pump, P.T.O, accessories etc. for 365 days comme cing from the date of supply at MDL on stamp paper. Also other equipment, material and material I of construction or accessories original guarantee / warranty certificates shall be submitted separately for details refer Technical specification.
 - a. The Supplier cannot absolve their responsibility for warranty of material even though it is inspected by & approved by the inspection authorities.
 - a. If the defects are not remedied within a reasonable/stipulated time, MDL may proceed to rectife the defects at the supplier's risk & cost, but without prejudice to MDL's rights under the contract
 - a. During the period of warranty / guarantee if any defect is noticed in the equipment / item supp ed, the supplier/ contractor will have to rectify such defects immediately at no extra cost to MI L. For such rectification/repair work, if the supplier needs to take the supplied item/equipment

ut of MDL (in full or part), the supplier shall submit a separate BG of equivalent amount of value of item being taken out, to cover the cost of item.

7) INSPECTION:

- a. A 4 Stage inspection have been carried out as per technical specification.
- b. The decision of the Inspecting Authority or their representatives, as the case may be, on any question of the intent, meaning and the scope of Specifications / Standards shall be final, conclusive and binding on the Bidder/ Supplier / Contractor.
- C. The Bidder /Supplier / Contractor shall accord all facilities to Purchaser's Inspectors /Nominated Agency to carry out Inspection / Testing during course of manufacture / final testing.
- d. <u>Receipt Inspection</u>: MDL (Mbi) shall carry out necessary inspection of the items on receipt in he MDL on the basis of appropriate MDL Inspection system requirements & the Inspection doc ments submitted by suppliers. Any objection raised by MDL (Mbi) inspection team against qua ty of material or workmanship shall be satisfactorily corrected by the supplier at his expenses i cluding replacement as may be required within shortest possible time within 30 days. Items do maged during transit shall also be rectified or replaced by the supplier within shortest possible ime. Goods accepted by the purchaser at the initial and final inspections in terms of the contra t, shall in no way dilute the purchaser's right to reject them later if found deficient in terms of the e warranty clause of the contract.
- e. Rejection of the material: Any portion of the equipment found defective/rejected, the supp er shall collect the same at his cost from the MDL Yard, all incidental charges being born by supplier, (inclusive of custom duty, if payable), within 30 days from the date of intimation to the supplier of such rejection. The MDL reserves the rights to dispose-off the rejected item at the enc of a total period of 90 days in any manner, to the best advantage to the MDL& recover storage charges & any consequential damages, from sale proceeds of such disposal.
- 8) **R.T.O REQUIREMENT & INSURANCE:** The bidder shall provide insurance for the above complete vehicle for a period of 365days from the date of supply of complete vehicle. For details refere echnical specification.
- 9) PAYMENT TERMS & PAYMENT MODE: As per payment timelines mentioned in the GeM bid.

10) **CONSIGNEE**:

Item scheduled for delivery is to be delivered at MDL Mumbai Yard, Mumbai, 400010, Maharas htra. for details refer Technical specification

- ii. Unloading of the equipment/ items are to be arranged by supplier.

In case of door delivery orders, the supplier shall direct the transporter to deliver the orderec items without insisting for consignee copy of the Lorry Receipt.

11) LIQUIDATED DAMAGES (LD):

LD clause shall be applicable as per GEM condition 0.5% percent of the delivered price of the delayed Goods and/or incidental Works/ Services for each week of delay or part hereof until actual delivery or performance, However, this LD shall not be applicable in case the ordered items are delivered as per scheduled delivery date.

Note: LD is applicable with maximum ceiling as per GeM terms and conditions.
